

**LEGAL NOTICE**

Department Pistols for the East Haven Police Department

The Town of East Haven Police Department seeks bids for the purchase of **Glock 45 Gen5 MOS COA**, with Aimpoint COA optic 9mm pistols; **Glock 43X MOS COA, with Aimpoint COA optic 9mm pistols**; UTM Glock 19/45 Gen 5 MMR MOS Kits, Glock Magazine 43X, 48 10 round, Glock Magazine 17 round; Gen 5 package, and Ring's Bluegun Firearm Simulator Glock 45.

**SEALED BIDS SHALL BE SUBMITTED TO THE OFFICE OF THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE, TOWN HALL, LOWER LEVEL, 250 MAIN STREET, EAST HAVEN, CONNECTICUT 06512, ON OR BEFORE THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 06, 2025 at 11:00 A.M. WHEN THEY WILL BE OPENED PUBLICLY. BIDS SUBMITTED AFTER THAT DATE/TIME SHALL BE REJECTED. THE BID TABULATION WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR VIEWING ON THE TOWN WEBSITE.**

All Bids shall be submitted only from entities lawfully authorized to sell firearms and registered to do business in the state of Connecticut. Bidders must be qualified by having completed multiple successful similar projects in Connecticut in the past five (5) years, in order to insure performance of the work required by the bid documents. All bids shall be based on the supply of the goods/services per specifications as indicated in the bid document. Strict compliance with the specifications is mandatory.

Specifications and forms on which bids must be submitted may be obtained at the Finance Office on or after **WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 22, 2025**, or for viewing and/or printing from the Town website: <https://www.easthaven-ct.gov>. There is no charge for the bid packet.

Sealed Bids must be submitted in triplicate – one (1) original and two (2) copies.

The Director of Finance and the Town reserve the right to reject any or all bids and/or to waive defects, informalities or irregularities in same if it is deemed by the Town, in its sole discretion, to be in the best interest of the Town.

It is the sole responsibility of the Bidder to ensure the bid is received by the proper authority prior to the bid opening time. Bids received after this time will be rejected. Upon award of the bid, the winning bidder shall be bound by the bid proposal price throughout the contract period.

Minority and female-owned companies are invited to participate and all bids will be afforded equal consideration.

## **General Specifications**

The East Haven Police Department (EHPD) seeks bids from qualified and responsible entities for the purchase of the items listed below. The quantity of each item listed below are the MINIMUM quantities of each item that will be purchased upon award of the bid. However, the Bidder shall carefully review Requirement Notes to Bidder #7 which outlines how unit pricing will apply to future purchases after the initial procurement. Also note the price listed by the Bidder on the pricing sheet are listed as PER UNIT.

- Seventy-five (75) Glock 45 Gen5 MOS COA, with Aimpoint COA optic pistols.
- Twenty (20) Glock 43X MOS COA, with Aimpoint COA optic 9mm pistols.
- Eight (8) UTM Glock 19/45 Gen 5 MMR MOS Kit P2's.
- Twenty-four (24) Glock Magazine 43X- 10 round.
- Twenty (20) Glock Magazine 17 round; Gen 5 package.
- Five (5) Ring's (or comparable) Bluegun Firearm Simulator Glock 45. The bid shall also include a credit for the trade-in of used Sig Sauer P320 X-Carry 9mm pistols with Romeo-1 Pro 6 MOA optics and of used Sig Sauer P365 XL 9mm pistols with Romeo Zero optics. This bid shall be based on the supply of the goods/services per specifications as indicated in the bid document.

The Bidder shall also provide credit for the EHPD trading in the items listed below. The Bidder shall list the amount of credit per unit turned in on the pricing sheet.

The specifications listed below set forth the necessary equipment requirements for Glock 45 Gen5 MOS COA, with Aimpoint COA optic 9mm Pistols, Glock 43X MOS COA, with Aimpoint COA optic 9mm pistols, and UTM Glock 19/45 Gen 5 MMR MOS Kit P2, Glock Magazine 43X, 10 round, Glock Magazine 17 round; Gen 5 package, and Ring's (or comparable) Bluegun Firearm Simulator Glock 45.

#### **REQUIREMENT NOTES TO BIDDERS**

1. No substitutions outside of the brand(s) listed in this bid will be accepted.
2. Bidder must have all necessary Federal and State licenses, permits, approvals, authorizations and intellectual property rights to submit a bid, sell/distribute and deliver the specified products and do business in Connecticut
3. All prices are to be FOB East Haven, Connecticut.
4. Delivery of all orders will be to the East Haven Police Department, 471 North High Street, East Haven, CT 06512.
5. Delivery time may affect award of bid.
6. Bidder must provide any/all standard manufacturer's service/operating literature and warranties that may be included with the equipment. All warranties shall be effective the day the equipment is delivered to the East Haven Police Department.
7. Bidders shall hold the successful bid prices firm for a period not to exceed two (2) years from the date of award. The per unit pricing does not require a minimum quantity of each item to be ordered after the initial procurement.
8. Envelope(s) must be plainly marked **BID 26-03, Police Department Pistols** with time of **November 6, 2025 11 a.m.**
9. Bids must be submitted on the bid sheet.
10. Bidder will indicate estimated delivery time frame in weeks from the order date on the bid pricing sheet.
11. Proof, satisfactory to the Town, of all certifications, licenses and insurances shall be submitted with the bid.
12. Conditional bids are subject to rejection in whole or in part. A conditional bid is defined as one which limits or modifies any of the terms and conditions and/or specifications of the Invitation to Bid.

13. Alternate bids will not be considered unless specifically requested in the original bid package. An alternate bid is defined as one which is submitted in addition to the bidder's base bid set forth in the **Invitation to Bid**. Town shall have the right to accept alternates in any order or combination, unless otherwise specifically provided in the bid documents, and to determine the low bidder on the basis of the sum of the base bid and alternates accepted.
14. Each bidder, by signing and submitting a bid, represents that the bidder has read and understands the specifications documents and all addendums, and the bid has been made in accordance therewith. Moreover, by submitting a bid, each Proposer acknowledges and agrees that it will, within five (5) business days of receipt of notice of award from the Town, execute the contract provided by the Town without alteration or modification.
15. Each bidder recognizes and agrees that the Town is subject to the Freedom of Information Act of the Connecticut General Statutes and, as such, any information contained in or submitted with or in connection with bidder's bid is subject to disclosure if required by law or otherwise. Bidder expressly waives any claims that bidder or any of its successors and/or assigns has or may have against the Town or any of its directors, officers, employees or authorized agents as a result of any such disclosure.
16. Each bidder represents that it is qualified, based on having completed multiple successful similar projects in Connecticut in the past five (5) years, to fully perform the work required by the bid documents. When specifically requested, the Town shall have the right to take such steps as it deems necessary to determine the ability of the bidder to perform his/her obligations under the contract, and the bidder shall furnish the Town all such information and data for this purpose as it may request. The right is reserved to reject any bid where an investigation of the available evidence or information does not satisfy the Town that the bidder is qualified to carry out properly the terms of the contract.
17. The bidder shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Town, its agents and employees from and against all claims, damages, losses and expenses, including attorney's fees arising out of, in whole or in part, the performance of the contract, or any negligent or willful act or omission of the bidder, its subcontractors, employees or agents, including, without limitation, claims, damages, loss and expense attributable to bodily injury, sickness, disease or death or injury to or destruction of tangible property, including the loss of use resulting there from or attributable to any type of pollution and/or environmental impairment or release into or upon land, the atmosphere, or any course or body of water that is above or below ground. The indemnification obligation under this Section shall not be limited in anyway by any limitation of the amount or type of damages, compensation or benefits payable by or for the bidder, its subcontractors, agents or employees under worker's compensation,

disability benefit acts or other employee benefit acts. This indemnity shall survive the expiration or early termination of the contract.

18. The bidder shall comply with all Federal, State and local laws and regulations, and shall procure all necessary license and permits, pay all charges and fees and give all notice necessary and incident to the due and lawful performance of the contract and bid process.
