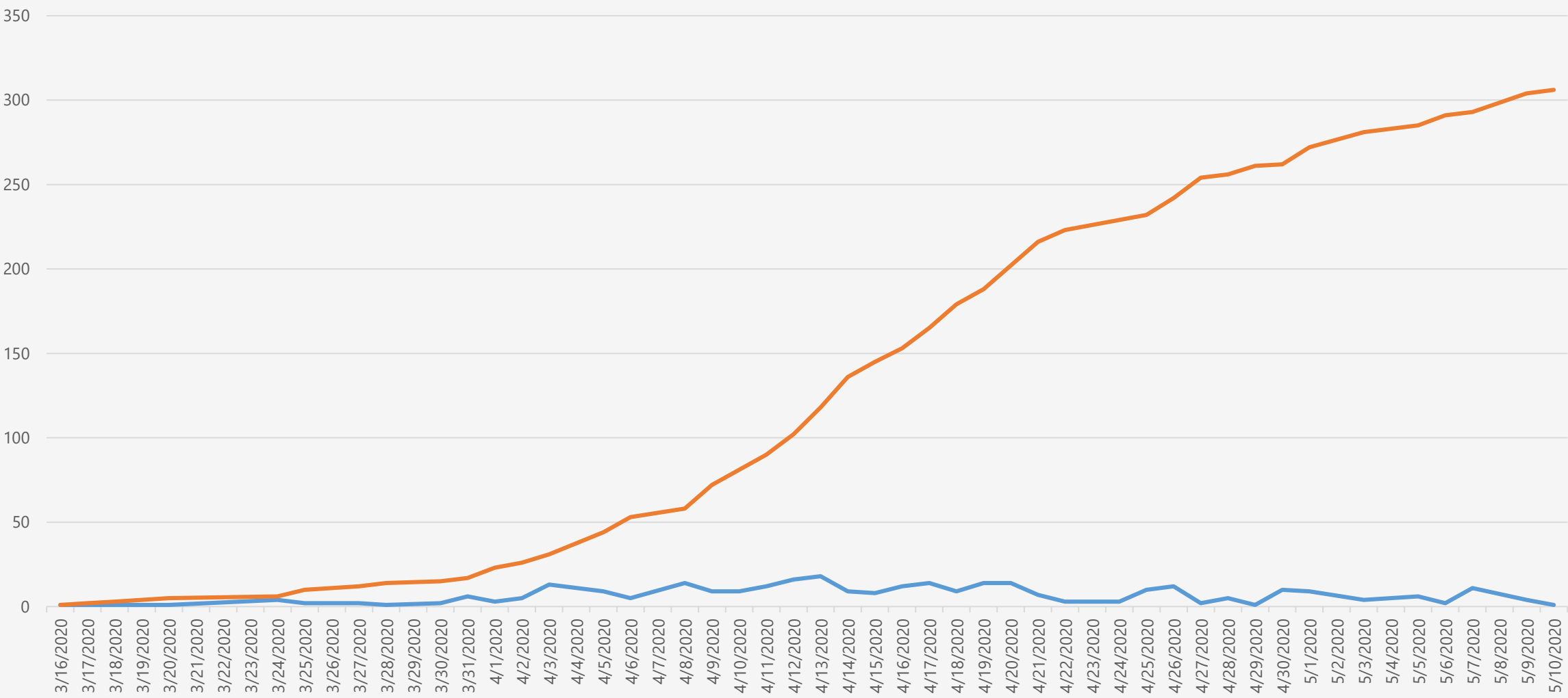

East Haven COVID-19 Facts and Figures

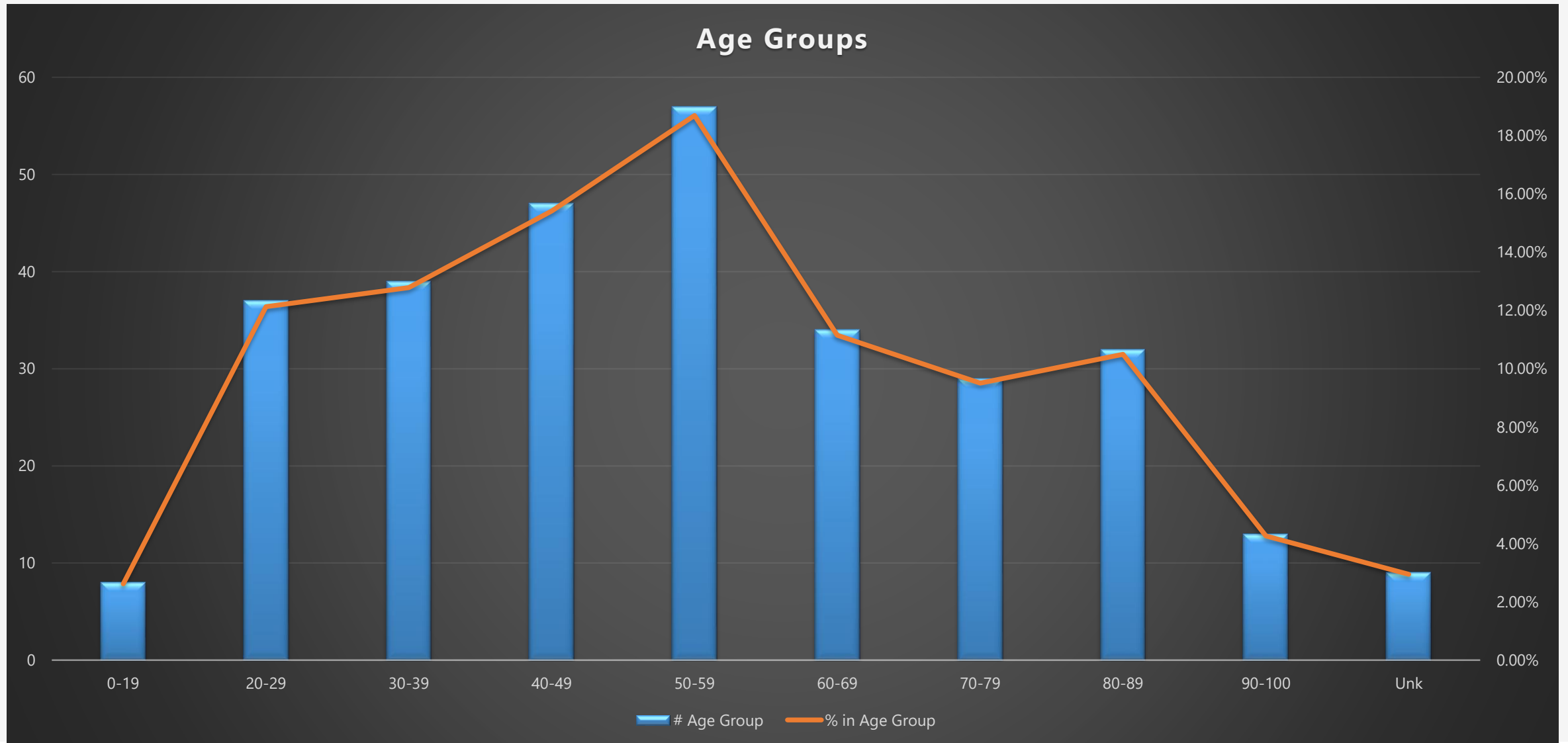
- Currently based on numbers between multiple sources there are 305 people positive for COVID-19. There have been 32 fatalities due to COVID-19 or complications related to COVID-19.
- State data on May 10 has East Haven at 338 cases but our numbers from multiple sources indicate 305, attributed to State Database Errors, Delay in Data, Incorrect Addresses. All charts are based on May 10 State data.
- When reviewing data, consider that the Town is not notified of persons who are testing negative after a positive which inflates the case number in East Haven
- Town Hall workers returned to work May 4th, Town Hall remains closed to the public.
- Town Administration is formulating a plan for re-opening.

Progression of COVID-19

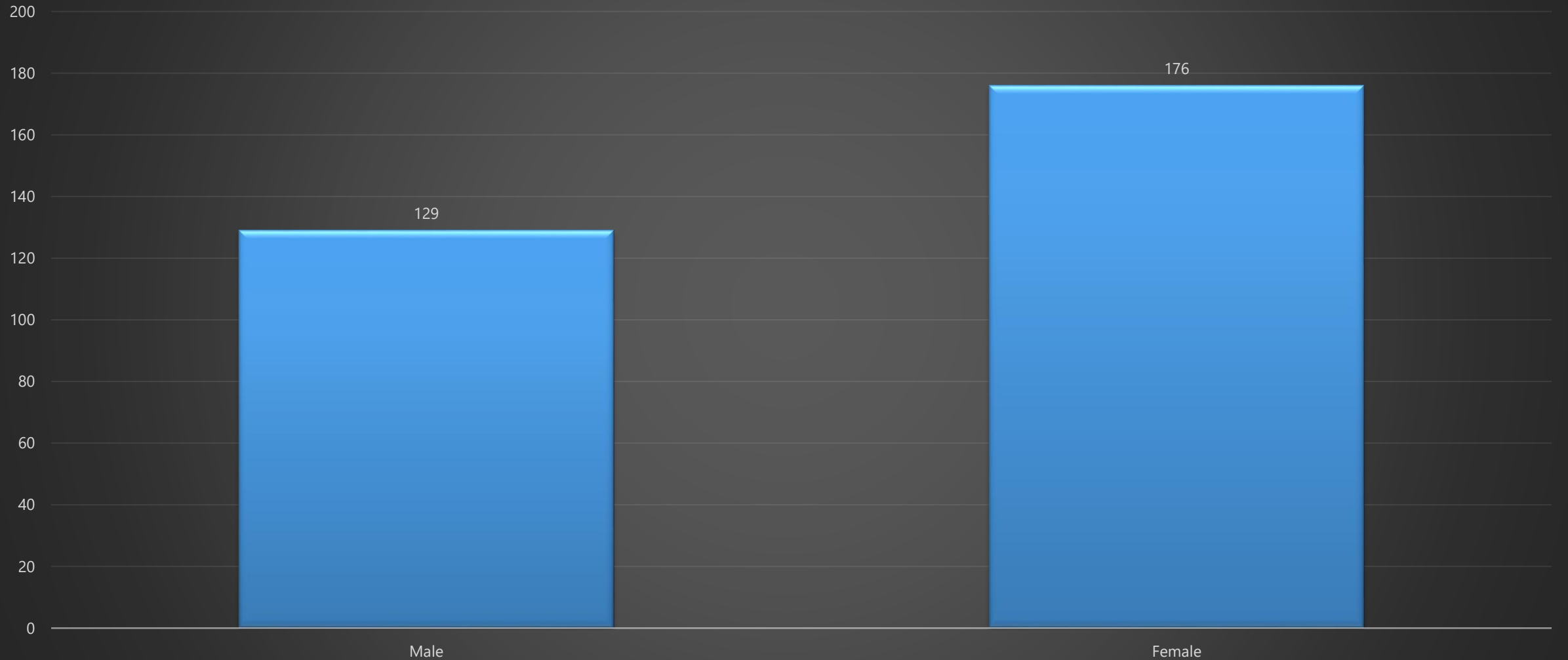


Case Numbers By Age Group



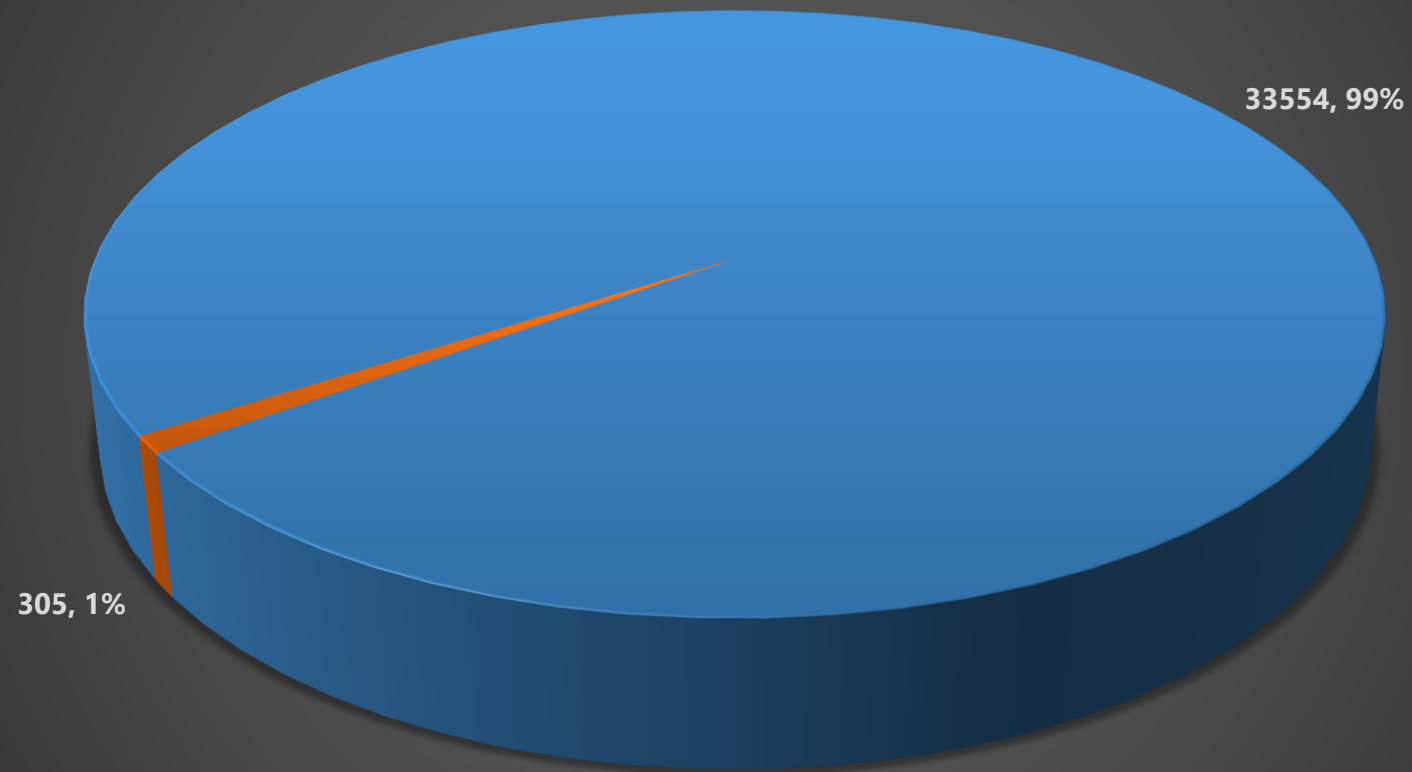
Where are Positive Cases in Town?

Male VS. Female Infection



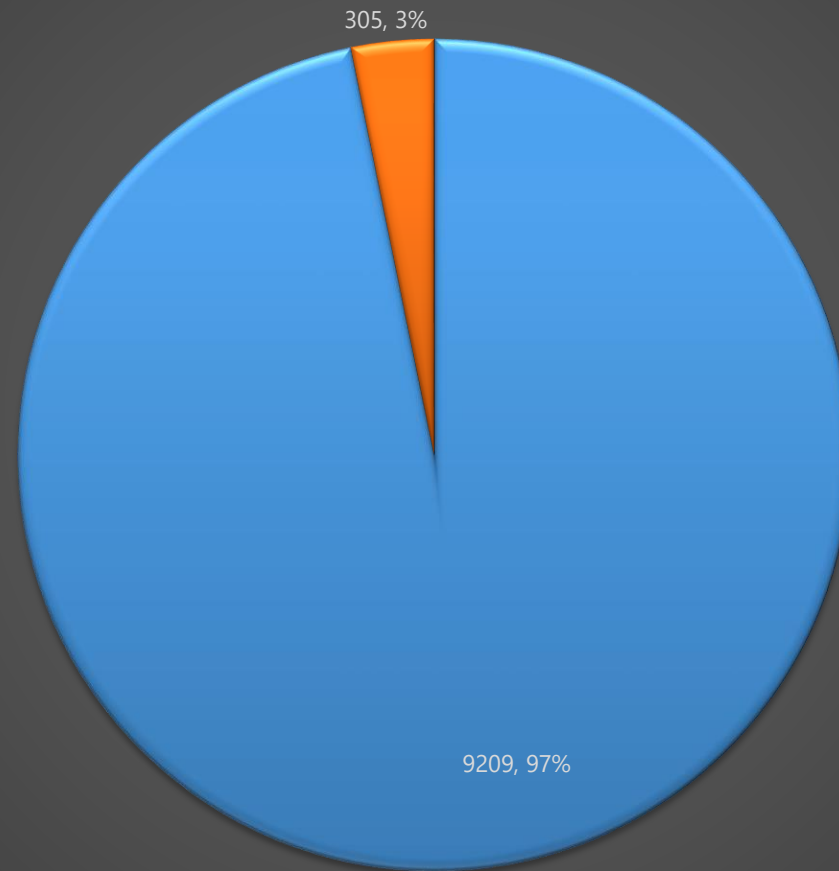
How Does East Haven Compare to Connecticut?

Positive Cases East Haven vs. Connecticut

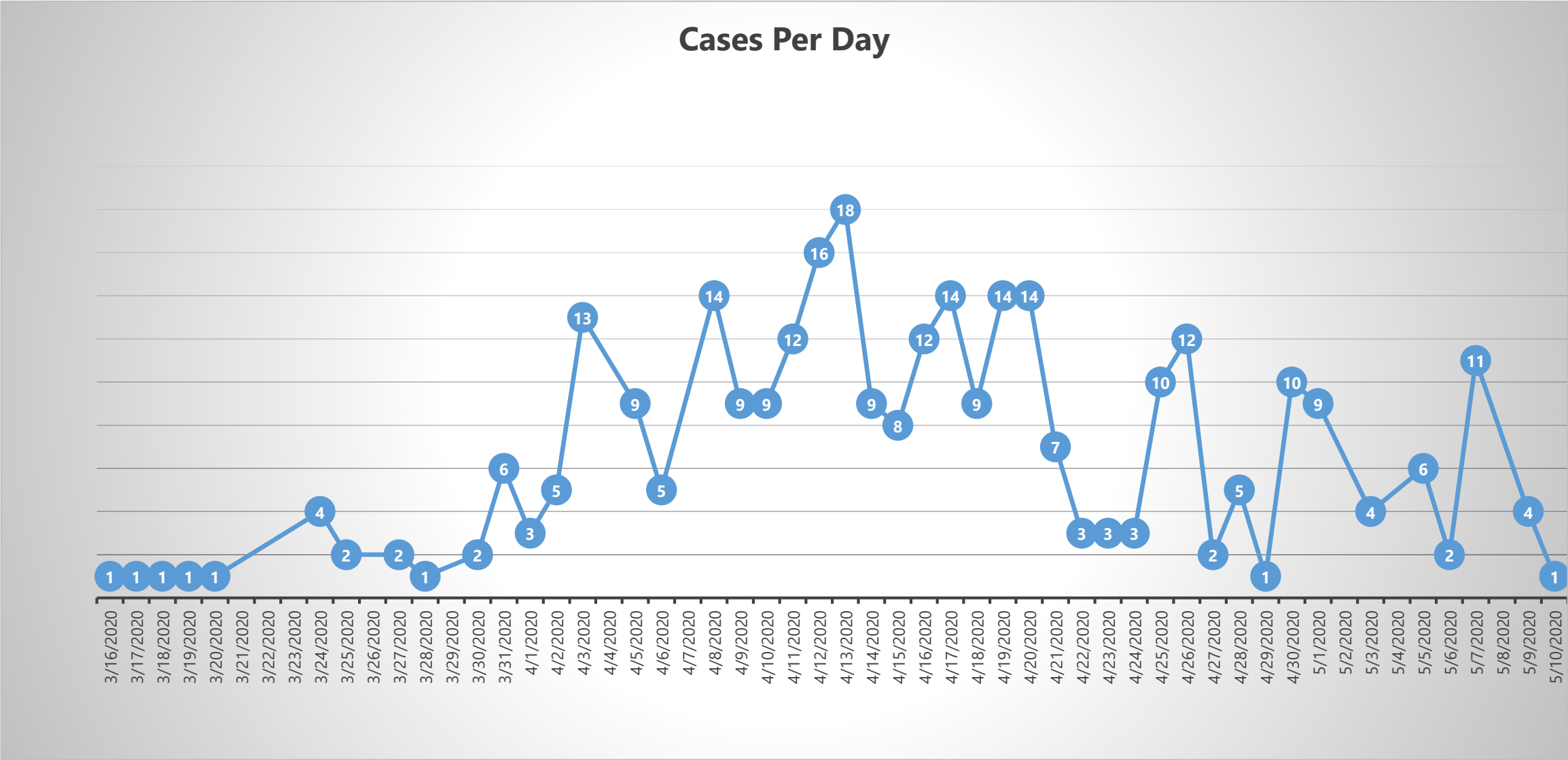


East Haven vs. New Haven County

East Haven: only 3% of the County for Positive Cases

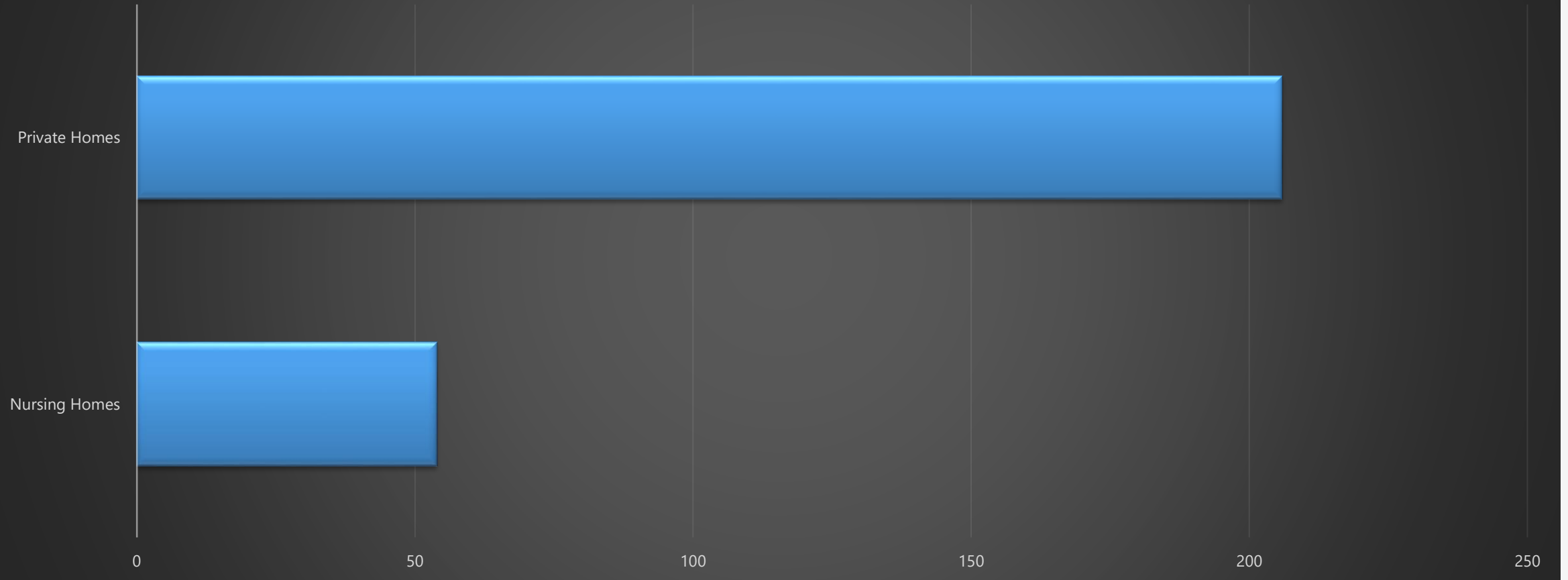


First Case of COVID-19 was March 16, 2020
