# APPLICATION FOR PERMISSION TO CONDUCT A REGULATED ACTIVITY WITHIN AN INLAND WETLAND OR WATER COURSE AREA

(In accordance with the Rules and Regulations regulating Inland Wetlands and Water Courses in the Town of East Haven, Connecticut).

As the Applicant, you are responsible for submitting **ALL** data, which is necessary for the local Inland Wetlands and Watercourses Commission to review your Application and make a fair evaluation of the issues.

Your failure to provide <u>ALL</u> the appropriate data may delay processing of this Application and may result in denial.

To minimize problems, you are advised to read the local Inland Wetland and Watercourses Regulations.

Application for a Permit from the Inland Wetland and Water Course Commission shall be made to the Town Engineer NO LATER THAN NOON (12:00) - TEN (10) BUSINESS DAYS PRIOR to the scheduled Board Meeting on forms furnished by him prior to any construction activities and may include, but not be limited to the following: letter from Applicant describing proposed work; maps, drawings, plans drawn to scale showing the nature, location and dimensions of the area in question; a copy of the Assessor

Field Card on the property, all proposed construction activities to include: existing or proposed structures, fill, storage of materials, drainage facilities, soil scientist report if required, and the location of the foregoing. Failure to comply with this time frame means your Application WILL NOT make the Agenda for the month but will be placed on the Agenda for the following month.

SIX (6) COPIES of ALL written material, drawings, reports, plans, etc. as well as this Original and ALL written material, drawings, reports, plans, etc. are to be included with this Application. (TOTAL six (6) copies of all and one (1) original of all TOTAL SEVEN (7) SETS.

#### FEES:

A Surcharge Fee (in addition to the Municipal Fee) shall be placed on <u>ALL</u> Applications. The Fee is as follows (inclusive of the State of Connecticut DEP fee of \$28.00 and the Town of East Haven fee of \$2.00):

### 19.1

Method of payment

All fees required by these Regulations shall be submitted to the Agency by certified check or money order payable to the Town of East Haven at the time the Application is filed with the Agency. 19.2

No Application shall be granted or approved by the Agency unless the correct Application fee is paid in full or unless a waiver has been granted by the Agency pursuant to Sub-section 19.7 of these 19.3

The Application fee is not refundable.

### 19.4

Definitions. As used in this section:

Residential Uses means activities carried out on property developed for permanent housing or being developed to be occupied by permanent housing.

Commercial Uses means activity carried out on property developed for industry, commerce, trade, recreation or business or being developed to be occupied for such purposes, for profit or non-profit.

Other Uses means activity other than residential uses or commercial uses.

Any portion of the complex Application fee in excess of the actual cost shall be refunded to the Applicant no later than 30 days after publication of the Agency's decision.
