## FALL FESTIVAL/EAST HAVEN COMMUNITY ROAD RACE TRAFFIC PATTERN INFORMATION

The 2021 Fall Festival is being held Friday, September 10 through Sunday, September 12. The East Haven Community Road Race will also be held on Saturday, September 11. During these events, portions of the roadways will be closed to all traffic and only local traffic will be allowed to pass (Not during Road Race). Detour signs will be in place to assist motorists around the events. The following traffic patterns will be in effect:

## **FALL FESTIVAL**

- Hemingway Avenue (RTE 142) between Edward Street and Main Street will be closed to all thru traffic. River Street will also be closed to all thru traffic between Hemingway Avenue and Park Place.
- Hemingway Avenue northbound will be closed at the intersection with Dodge Avenue with access for local traffic only.
- Please be mindful of the detour signs on Thompson Avenue and Dodge Avenue to access points north and south
  of the Fall Festival.
- Temporary "No Parking Signs" will be in place on Park Place (east side), River Street (north side), Chidsey Avenue (east side), and Edwards Street (north side). Enforcement will take place during the dates of the Fall Festival.
- Handicap parking will be located on Park Place (southbound along the Town Green)
- This traffic pattern will be in place during the following dates and times:

Friday, September 10 5:00 PM - 11:00 PM
Saturday, September 11 7:00 AM - 11:00 PM
Sunday, September 12 8:00 AM - 6:00 PM

## EAST HAVEN COMMUNITY ROAD RACE

- The East Haven Community Road Race route is as follows: Start Main Street/Park Place, south on Hemingway Avenue, west on Edward Street, south on Chidsey Avenue, south on Prospect Street, west on Dodge Avenue, south on Roma Street, south on Kenneth Street, west on Osmond Street, north on Thompson Avenue, west on Tyler Street, north on Gerrish Avenue, east on Main Street, ending at Main Street/Park Place.
- All roads mentioned above and their intersecting streets will be closed during the race.
- All roads will open up to traffic once the last runner passes through that particular location along the race route.
- Hemingway Avenue will be closed during the race. Northbound traffic on Coe Avenue will be detoured east
  onto Short Beach Road (RTE 142) toward Branford and westbound traffic on Short Beach Road will be detoured
  south onto Coe Avenue to Silver Sands Road (RTE 337) to New Haven.
- Those attempting to get south of Hemingway Avenue/Short Beach Road can either take Townsend Avenue (New Haven) to South End Road or Alps Road (Branford) to Short Beach Road.
- This traffic pattern will be in effect for the Road Race on September 11 between 8:00 AM and 11:00 AM.
