RE: MAYOR PROVIDES UPDATE ON RWA'S ROAD PROJECT ON MILL STREET AND NORTH HIGH STREET TO BEGIN VERY SOON

Mayor Joseph Maturo, Jr would like area residents to be aware that the extensive road project by the Regional Water Authority involving Mill and North High Streets is expected to begin at any time now. The RWA will be installing a new 30" water main that will be affecting traffic in the areas from the State Rifle Range to Route 80 and from North High Street down Mill Street to Route 80. Once the work begins it will continue daily until the winter weather prevents paving, which the construction crews are expected to do daily in the areas where the work is taking place. The work will then resume once again as weather permits in the spring.

Traffic is expected to be reduced to one lane in the areas affected from 9am until 3 pm daily. Construction crews will be using the Farmer's field on North High Street as a staging area, which is evident by the mounds of fill currently be stored there.

Once the work is completed the new main will allow residents on Mill Street to have access to RWA water, which they do not have at present.
