"I am incredibly saddened by the CHRO complaint that was recently filed by Francine Carbone, an East Haven Town Hall employee, and the patently false allegations contained in that filing. Unfortunately, Ms. Carbone, a disgruntled employee who was on the verge of being terminated, chose to address her employment problems by filing a salacious complaint against me and the Town of East Haven.

With regard to the complaint itself, I am confident that as this legal process unfolds, further investigation will prove all of Ms. Carbone's allegations to be both unmerited and false.

Again, I am disappointed that Ms. Carbone has opted to engage in this course of antagonistic litigation. However, I will respect this legal process and defer any further legal comments to the attorneys handling this matter on behalf of the Town.

Most importantly, I wish to assure the residents of East Haven that my team and I will not allow this matter to deter or distract us from efficiently managing the day-to-day business of the Town. Our team has worked hard to provide residents with efficient, accountable, and reliable government and will continue to do so."
