- 1. <u>Call to Order:</u> Bill Jackson called the meeting to order at 7:32 p.m.

A letter was sent to Len Fasano requesting some help in obtaining a grant for expenses with the restoration of The Old Cemetery. He had not received the letter so Judy hand_delivered a copy of the same letter to him. She also attached a copy of an article that appeared in the New Haven Register regarding a potential bill to be passed to help neglected cemeteries in the State of Connecticut. Funding would be derived from fees collected from death certificates. Approximately \$40,000.00 in revenue is collected annually at the State level for these certificates, so it would not cost the taxpayers any additional monies.

There are still limbs down at the Old Cemetery. Bill would check to see if they were removed as yet by the Public Works Department. All the flags were put up at The Old Cemetery for Memorial Day. Some of them had fallen down, but Bill would go and repair them before the holiday.

Peggy was not able to locate the information regarding the grid that was compiled by some of the members of the board for the cemetery. She thinks they were probably destroyed once the boy scout, Will Henley took on the project in order to earn his badge.
