- (1) To consider and vote upon, pursuant to Section 6 "Emergency appropriations" of Chapter VII of the Town Charter, whether to recommend that the Town Council approve an emergency appropriation, the total amount of which, per said Charter provision, shall not exceed one (1) percent of the current tax levy in any one (1) fiscal year, to mitigate the effects of the public health emergency posed by the spread of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19).
