Dear Ms. Verderame:

On June 17, 2020, in my capacity as Inland Wetlands Enforcement Officer for the Town of East Haven, I observed violations to the Regulations for the Protection and Preservation of the Inland Wetlands and Watercourses of the Town of East Haven occurring on property owned by you at 1309 North Haven Street. These activities include:

- 1. Non-permitted removal of trees, vegetation, and soils within fifty (50) feet upland review area and
- 2. Grading and excavation within the upland review area.

The East Haven Inland Wetlands Commission has the authority and responsibility to regulate inland wetlands and watercourses in the Town of Est Haven under Sections 22a-36 through 22a-45a of the Connecticut General Statutes and under Sections 1.3 and 14 of the Regulations for the Protection and Preservation of the Inland Wetlands and Watercourses of the Town of East Haven, Connecticut.

Therefore, you are hereby ordered to immediately Cease and Desist all activities on the site.

To provide you with opportunity to be heard by the Commission and to show why this CEASE AND DESIST ORDER should not remain in effect, a Public Hearing has bee scheduled before the Commission for Wednesday, September 9, 2020 at 7:00 PM at the East Haven Senior

Center/Community Center at 91 Taylor Avenue, East Haven. You should be in attendance at the Public Hearing. The Commission shall consider the facts presented at the Hearing and within ten (10) days of the completion of the Hearing will notify you by certified mail that this CEASE AND DESIST ORDER remains in effect, that a revised is in effect, or that the order has been withdrawn. Pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes 22a-44, this CEASE AND DESIST ORDER is effective upon issuance and shall remain in effect until the Commission affirms, revises, or withdraws the order.
