



Chief's Report January 30, 2023

I. Logistics

- a. Engine 6 is at Detroit Diesel for an engine rebuild, it is expected to be back this week.
- b. Squad 1 was at New England Fire Apparatus for a collision repair from a hit and run and multiple other repairs.
- c. Squad 5 has been in service for leaky axle hubs.
- d. Engine 7 had a brake can replaced in-house and leaf springs on both sides repaired at Superior Spring.
- e. The buildout of FirstDue RMS continues, currently being used for fire reports (NFIRS), next phase is training reports which will commence February 4.

II. Operations

- a. The department took delivery of 6 new multi-ban portable radios purchased as part of ARPA to allow better interoperable communication with our mutual aid partners who operate on different bandwidths.
- b. Calendar year 2022 closed out with an unprecedented number of calls for service. The department responded on 7444 calls for service which is a 29%

III. Finance

- a. Our apparatus repair accounts are taking some heavy hits early in the fiscal year, a transfer of \$47,000 was submitted and will go to a public hearing on February 7.
- b. The Agreement between Local 1205 and the Town of East Haven was ratified by the Town Council.
- c. Work is underway on the 2023-2024 budget which will see increases in the salary lines due to the new collective bargaining agreement and modest increases due to rising inflation. The largest increase will be in apparatus repair because the fleet is getting older and the newer apparatus is transitioning out of warranty.
- d. The 2022 Assistance to Firefighters Grant opened, a request was made for \$140,070 for Paramedic Equipment. This is a high priority item which are typically the only projects



approved for an award. The grant application will go under an electronic review before moving on in the process.

IV. Buildings & Facilities

- a. A severe leak developed on the roof of the apparatus floor, an emergency repair was authorized and the entire roof will have a new membrane applied.
- b. A new kitchen was installed at Station 4, this included cabinets, countertops and appliances.

V. Personnel Matters

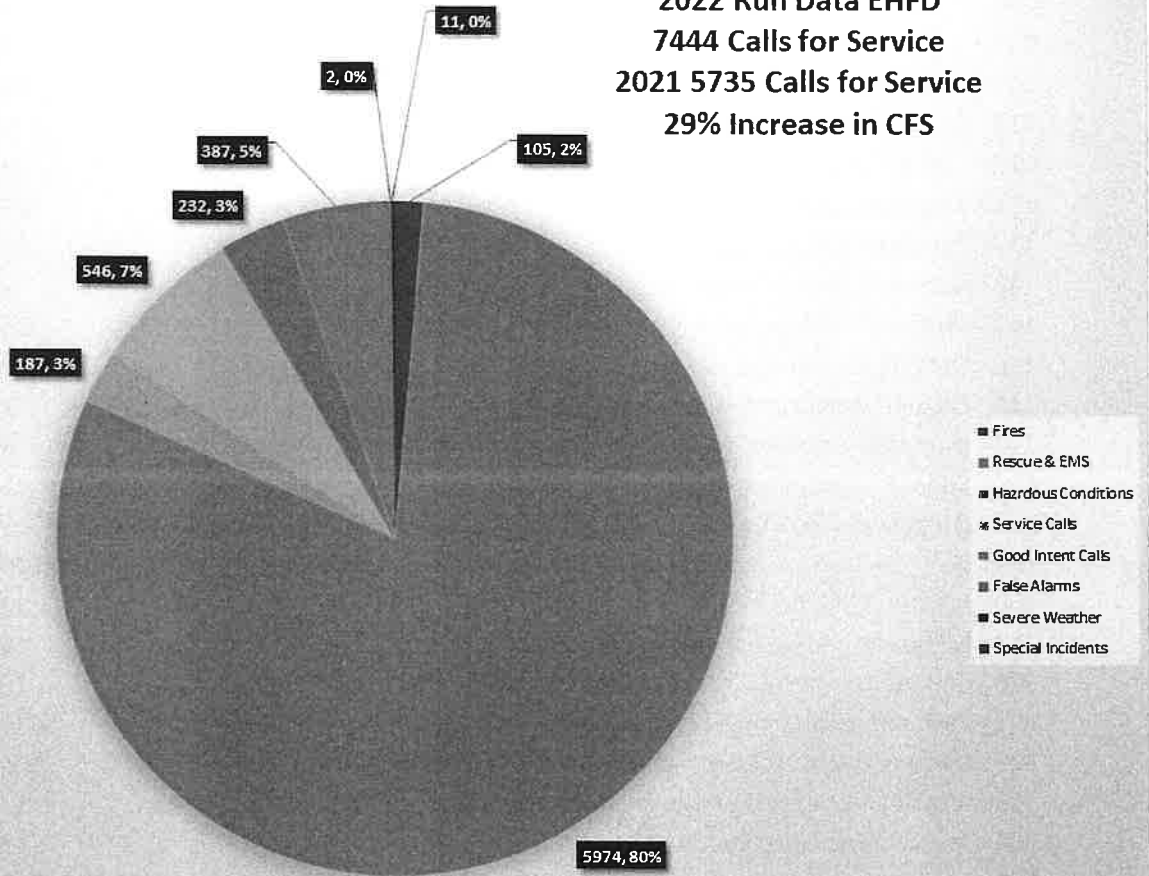
- a. Lateral transfer Harrison Newman began work as a probationary firefighter / paramedic.
- b. The following Captains completed Fire Officer I certification training; Captains Gordon Stewart and Michael Cieplak.
- c. Three recruits completed the academy December 9 and are now assigned to shift and are progressing well. They have successfully completed their 3-month performance review and are progressing as expected.
- d. Four employees completed their 6-month performance evaluations and are meeting all benchmarks.
- e. There is one more retention plan period in July of 2023. Due to the new CBA we are unsure if the two remaining eligible employees will request its use.

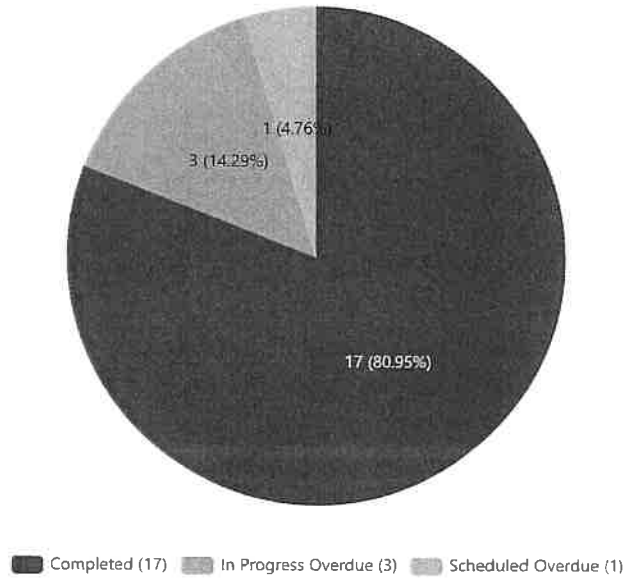
