



**PROCLAMATION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY**  
**Town of East Haven, Connecticut**

**WHEREAS**, on August 27, 2020 I, Joseph A. Carfora, Mayor of the Town of East Haven hereby finds that due to unexpected, dangerous, and extreme weather conditions, including but not limited to, downed trees, downed power lines, and structural damages throughout the Town of East Haven, a condition of extreme peril to life and property did, and does exist in the Town of East Haven; and

**WHEREAS**, I, Joseph A. Carfora, Mayor of the Town of East Haven must take this action because it has now been found that local resources are unable to cope with the effects of said emergency; and

**WHEREAS, I HEREBY DECLARE**, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes Section 28-8 et. seq., that a state of emergency now exists in the Town of East Haven as a result of dangerous and unsafe conditions that now exist; and

**I FURTHER DECLARE**, that such state of emergency shall exist until declared to be terminated; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED** that a copy of this proclamation be forwarded to the Governor of the State of Connecticut with the request that he proclaim the Town of East Haven to be in a state of emergency; and

**IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED** that **MATTHEW MARCARELLI, FIRE CHIEF / EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT DIRECTOR** is hereby designated as the authorized representative of the Town of East Haven for the purpose of receipt, processing, and coordination of all inquiries and requirements necessary to obtain state and federal assistance.
