The Shoreline MIECHV Program is a Parents as Teachers (PAT) accredited home visiting program working in collaboration with Nurturing Families Network.



### How can we help?

- The Home Visiting Program is a free service for pregnant women in the towns of East Haven and West Haven.
- MIECHV's well-trained home visitors provide...
  - Weekly home visits
  - Pregnancy and parenting information
  - Developmental screenings
  - o Father guidance
  - o Monthly get-together's
  - Connections to resources in the community and access to baby supplies
- Services are offered midpregnancy (before 27<sup>th</sup> week) up to child's age 5.
- Children whose families enroll in this program are more prepared for kindergarten.
